

Dear Friends and Sponsors,

In 2002, Smith Barney staff and other community leaders combined efforts to channel support for Pediatric Autism Services at the John Heinz Institute.

For years, Smith Barney has partnered with the Allied Services John Heinz Institute of Rehabilitation Medicine to present a golf tournament that has raised more than \$300,000 with last year's event setting a record net proceeds of \$65,000!

In 2008, one in every 150 American children were diagnosed with some form of Autism, according to the Centers for Disease Control. The enormous cost of treating Autistic children is not typically covered by insurance. John Heinz Rehab will provide therapy to any Autistic child, regardless of his/her family's ability to pay. An average 13-week speech and language therapy session costs approximately \$3,000. This year's proceeds will help to defray the cost of such services, and none of the money raised through the event will be used for salaries.

Your support will assure continuation of intensive one-on-one therapy services for these children at John Heinz Rehab. We look forward to seeing you at this year's benefit golf tournament.
